

# Autumn in the Adirondacks

## CARavan

Hosted by the Metro Region – CCCA

September 9 – 18, 2010

You are invited to join us on a memorable tour to the Adirondack Park in northern New York State, an area of six million acres, much of which has been designated “Forever Wild.” Our tour begins and ends in Lake Placid, named “Number One Outdoor Town in America,” the only town in the U.S. to have hosted two Winter Olympic Games. We will provide admission to all Olympic venues, plus enjoy an

exclusive demonstration of the 90-meter ski jump and freestyle aerials by athletes that may have participated in the 2010 winter games.

We will be driving our Classics on beautiful, uncrowded roads through small towns and wilderness areas. Because of the nature of the area, most meals will be included in your fee. Our opening banquet will be Thursday, September 9<sup>th</sup> at Lake Placid’s High Peaks Resort, which has recently undergone a total renovation.

Friday and Saturday we will visit historical points of interest including a fascinating natural history museum, a boat builder and restorer of classic boats, a rarely seen collection of original Classic cars and Paul Smith’s College on beautiful Lower St. Regis Lake.

Sunday and Monday will be spent in the Thousand Islands area with a visit to the renowned Antique Boat Museum with perhaps a ride in a triple cockpit Hacker Craft as well as a tour of a Gilded-Age houseboat. Staying in Alexandria Bay, we will tour the Thousand Islands on a chartered boat with a stop at the magnificent, romantically inspired Boldt Castle.

Tuesday brings us back to the Adirondack Park driving along the mighty St. Lawrence and then on wilderness roads to Lake Placid. The High Peaks loop drive will be our schedule for Wednesday with a stop at the extraordinary Adirondack Museum in Blue Mountain Lake.



Thursday dawns with a drive across Lake Champlain to Vermont, where we will visit the Morgan Horse Farm before enjoying lunch at the Middlebury Inn. We will then visit the Shelburne Museum, the fabulous Americana collection of Electra Havemeyer Webb before returning to Lake Placid by way of the Charlotte-Essex ferry. Driving north along the Ausable River Friday, we will visit Ausable Chasm and enjoy hiking the chasm as well as having a picnic lunch. We plan to celebrate the

time of year with a “Nearly Oktoberfest” dinner that evening at the Lodge at Whiteface Mountain upon our return from touring.

So that the town’s residents and visitors may enjoy and appreciate our Full Classics®, we are planning a parade through Lake Placid on Saturday morning with a tour in a vintage boat on the lake in the afternoon, culminating with the final banquet that evening.

We have many more exciting details planned and promise a great value for your \$1,000 activity fee. Above all, we guarantee a Classic adventure that will be most memorable as well as a great deal of FUN!

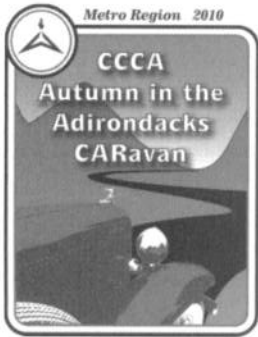

In addition to touring the Adirondack Park we will travel west to the Thousand Islands along the St. Lawrence River and east to the Vermont side of Lake Champlain. The area you will be visiting is steeped in history from the Gilded Age Great Camps to a town that hosted two Olympic Games.

Because of the wilderness area, we will be providing most of your meals: ten breakfasts, eight lunches and eight dinners. Fascinating museums, antique boats, a private car collection, touring a Rhineland-style castle and watching Olympic athletes perform are just a few of the exciting events we have planned for you. This is a semi-hub tour, staying at two hotels – three days at Lake Placid's High Peaks Resort, two days at Alexandria Bay's Riveredge Resort and then back to Lake Placid at the High Peaks for five days. The size of our CARavan is limited to 100 rooms at the High Peaks Resort which, if utilized, will give us sole occupancy of the hotel.

Our activity fee of \$1,000 per person includes most events plus many extras; our hotel costs will be \$198.24 for the High Peaks Resort, single or double and \$173.41 double and \$152.60 single for the Riveredge Resort. **These figures include all taxes.** Excellent trailer parking is available. The Adirondack Regional Airport is only 16 miles from Lake Placid.
